WEBMASTER ACTIVITY

Updates and Changes to Website Pages

Changes during the last month included:

- Posted the Scholarship Foundation operating procedures and bylaws on the website with links to them on the SCHOLARSHIPS page and on the (yet-to-be-approved-and-posted) HRSC BYLAWS page.
- Added the Honeywell Aerospace Challenge judging volunteer opportunity as an event for February and forwarded it to Linda Gregerson for inclusion in the Bridge. (The same information was provided to members last year.)
- Added a note on the home page reminding members that the club year ends at the end of April; not the end of December. (Darrell Golic had told me that many members seem unaware of this, and as a result become delinquent on their dues, causing us extra work.)
- Added a note on the home page reminding members that the eBridge is intended for members only and should not be forwarded to non-members. (Ted Rees had sent me an example of the eBridge being forwarded to an extensive emailing list, albeit apparently with good intentions.)
- Updated the “Join Us!” section of the home page to emphasize benefits of membership and solicited suggestions for its improvement from board members.
- Added a note that the Honeywell Austria version of Honeywell’s history has been removed from the Honeywell Austria website, and that a response from Honeywell Austria is awaited.
- Added information from Frank Lynott about the opportunity to receive income tax preparation training from the AARP and then provide tax preparation services to those needing assistance. This was presented as an upcoming event for early January, since that is when the training will take place. Forwarded the same information to Linda Gregerson for inclusion in the November Bridge. (The same information was provided to members last year.)
- Added a senior discount section to the USEFUL LINKS page.
- Archived the HRC policies, procedures and bylaws and their change history on the ARCHIVES page in light of their imminent replacement by the HRSC versions.

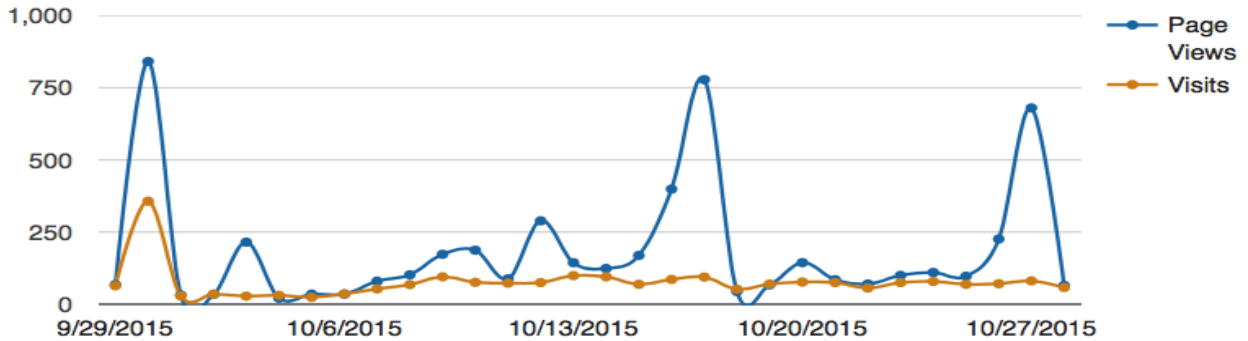
Email, Hotline and Website Administration
